Assessment

All applicants will be automatically assessed by our Scholarship Committee based on academic merit and final grades. No additional submissions are necessary.

Eligibility Criteria

This scholarship is open to nationals of ASEAN member countries (including Singaporeans).

Assessment

Candidates are to submit an essay to our Scholarship Committee for review. Applicants may also submit any other documents which demonstrate their achievements. Our team will take this into account in our holistic assessment of your application.

Women in STEM Scholarship

Awarded to exceptional female candidates who have demonstrated leadership capabilities or potential in their personal endeavours. With this scholarship, we wish to promote gender balance and support women in enhancing their career opportunities.

Eligibility Criteria

This scholarship is open to female candidates who have been successfully admitted into any of our MSc Programmes.

Assessment

Candidates are to submit an essay to our Scholarship Committee for review. Applicants may also submit any other documents which demonstrate their achievements. Our team will take this into account in our holistic assessment of your application.
